Dear Assembly Member Bonta:

The California Association of Clerks and Election Officials Elections Legislative Committee is pleased to convey its **Support** for **AB 817** (as introduced February 21, 2013). This proposal would authorize a local elections official to appoint a non-citizen who is a lawful permanent resident and otherwise eligible to register to vote to serve as a deputy registrar of voters or as a precinct board member, under certain limitations.

Existing law requires the election official to appoint precinct board members to serve voters at the polls on Election Day. Election officials must also make efforts to recruit and place workers who are fluent in languages used by limited English-speaking voters and protected under the Voting Rights Act. Administered under the same provisions as existing legislation authorizing student poll workers, non-citizen precinct board members would not be eligible to process voted ballots or tally votes. This legislation is favorable as it will expand options for counties to recruit bilingual poll workers and deputy registrars from a larger pool of bilingual speakers, providing greater assistance for and access to the ballot for persons with language barriers.
