SUMMARY

AB 1121 RANKED VOTING

Authorizes the Secretary of State to approve not more than 12 cities or counties to conduct a local election using ranked voting if specified conditions are met. Requires local election officials to make certain reports relating to ranked voting elections. Also requires those cities and counties to report on the success of conducting those elections to the Legislative Analyst who shall then make a report to the Legislature. The authority of cities and counties to adopt ranked voting shall be repealed on January 1, 2019. Cities and counties previously authorized to conduct ranked voting elections shall be allowed to operate until January 1, 2024.

RETURN OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS: MILITARY

Requires that the vote by mail ballot of a special absentee voter, as defined, who is temporarily living outside the United States or the District of Colombia shall be timely cast if it is postmarked or signed and dated on or before election day and received by the voter's election official no later than 21 days after the election.
