Dear Members of the Assembly Committee on Elections and Redistricting:

The California Association of Clerks and Election Officials Elections Legislative Committee is pleased to convey its **Support** for **AB 1417** (as amended March 20, 2013), an omnibus bill that will repeal certain obsolete requirements, update to terminology and cross-references, and make amendments to certain state and local election official notices and mailings.

More specifically, this bill will:

- ★ Update terminology and cross references to reflect changes made by AB 1805.
- ★ Conform state law to federal law with regard to mailing ballot material to military and overseas voters and takes in to account the 45<sup>th</sup> day requirement;
- ★ Implement a notice procedure for the Secretary of State if a candidate ops to change his or her ballot designation between the primary and general elections;
- ★ Repeal and delete cross-references to an obsolete requirement for the county elections official to prepare a list of candidates for presidential delegates for each party;
- ★ Make corresponding changes to Section 13309 of the California Elections Code relating to payment for printing and distribution of a statement of qualification for a candidate who claims financial indigence; and,
- ★ Repeal the limit on the number of technicians the Secretary of State could employ during the examination of voting systems.
