Dear Assembly Member Melendez:

The California Association of Clerks and Election Officials Elections Legislative Committee has reviewed **AB 813** (as introduced February 21, 2013), requiring the certified statement of the results of the election and the certified statement of the vote to be posted on the internet web sites of each local election official and Secretary of State in a downloadable spreadsheet format. The Committee has not taken a formal position on this bill but would like to share concerns raised during the discussion of this proposal:

- ★ <u>System Certification</u> Under existing systems specifications, manipulation of election data is prevented, and for good reason. Requiring all systems to produce alternate versions of the certified results and statements of the vote would require changes to certification and permissions to access vote data.
- ★ Cost While some system vendors have been able to extract and manipulate election results in alternate formats, local election officials spend hours to recreate results for the public in a user friendly format. Alternately, counties may seek a third-party vendor to alter the format of election results, and would have to bear that cost. While the proposal contains language relating to reimbursement through the State Commission on Mandates, the suspension of various existing election mandates puts future reimbursements in question.
- ★ Proposal is too vague Specifically, subsection (b) of section 15501 is written too vague. Requiring the downloadable file to be "compatible with a spreadsheet software application that is widely used at the time of the posting." is not clear. Changes in technology uses occur too often and what is widely used in one jurisdiction may not be widely used in another.
- ★ <u>Clarifying language</u> The Committee expressed concerns that election results may be manipulated by the public and presented in an alternate format, putting the integrity of the results in question. The integrity of the voting system and results is a major component of the acceptance of election results by the public. We would like to request clarifying language be added to indicate the results certified by the county and State are the <u>official</u> certified results.
